O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the closing of its agency station at Inyokern on its San Joaquin Division in Kern County.

Applicant alleges that the operation and maintenance of the agency station is unremunerative and is not justified by the volume of business transacted at the present time; and that the maintenance of Inyokern as a non-agency station will furnish adequate service to the public until such time as sufficient traffic will have developed justifying the re-establishment of the agency.

The Commission has carefully considered the statistical statements filed as exhibits herein and is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to close its agency station at Inyokern in Kern County on its San Joaquin Division and to hereafter maintain and operate said station as a

non-agency station until the further order of this Commission.
