ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the closing of its agency station at Emigrant Gap in Placer County on its Sacramento Division during the period from November 1st to April 30th, inclusive, of each year.

Applicant alleges that the maintenance of an agency station during the period in which closing is requested is unremunerative and is not justified by the amount of traffic offering; that the maintenance of a non-agency station during such months will adequately serve the needs of the traveling and shipping public until such time as sufficient business shall have been developed which will justify the continued maintenance of an agency station throughout the year.

We have given consideration to the statements showing traffic handled at this station and revenue derived therefrom and are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to close its agency station at Emigrant Gap on its Sacramento Division in Placer County during the period from November 1st

to April 30th, inclusive, of each year, and during such months to maintain and operate said station of Emigrant Gap as a non-agency station, and such procedure to continue until the further order of this Commission.
