ORDER

In this proceeding H. E. Schuricht and F. E. Ruweler are asking for an order by the Commission approving an agreement to lease to J. B. and O. B. Griffiths the operative right under which Schuricht & Ruweler have been operating an auto freight transportation service between Los Angeles, Alhambra, San Gabriel and intermediate points. The lease which is to run for a period of five years, provides for a monthly payment of \$25.00 and contains an option to purchase. In addition to the operative right the lease covers terminal facilities at 1479 E. 6th Street, Los Angeles. No equipment is involved.

The operative right was originally established prior to May 1, 1917 by Frank Powell. On his death it was transferred to his widow, Viola Powell, and the latter, in Application No. 9592, secured authority from the Commission to transfer the right to Schuricht & Ruweler.

We believe that this application should be granted and that it is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following provisions:

1. That applicants, Schuricht & Ruweler, shall immediately cancel tariff of rates and time schedules covering, certificate for which is herein authorized to be leased.

2. That applicants J. B. and O. B. Griffiths shall immediately adopt as their own tariff of rates and time schedules for said service as heretofore filed by Schuricht & Ruweler.

3. That such cancellation and adoption shall be in accordance with General Order No. 51.

4. That the operative right herein authorized to be leased may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission.

5. No vehicle may be operated by applicants Griffiths & Griffiths unless such vehicle is owned by said applicants or is leased under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
