ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance of the agency station at Rosamond in Los Angeles County on its San Joaquin Division.

Applicant alleges that the maintenance of the agency is unremunerative and is not justified by the volume of business transacted at such station; and that the future maintenance and operation of said station as a non-agency will furnish adequate service to the public until such time as additional traffic develops which justifies the restoration of an agency.

The Commission has given consideration to the statistical statements covering the passenger and freight traffic handled during the year ending March 31, 1924, and the revenue derived therefrom. We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to discontinue the maintenance of an agent at Rosemond in Los Angeles County on its San Joaquin Division and to hereafter maintain and operate said station as a non-agency station until the further order of this Commission.
