## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance of an agency at its station of Acton in Los Angeles County on its San Joaquin Division.

Applicant alleges that the maintenance of an agency at this station is unremunerative and is not justified by the volume of business transacted at said station; and that the maintenance of a non-agency station will furnish adequate service to the public until such time as additional traffic will be developed in volume sufficient to warrant the re-establishment of an agent.

The Commission has given consideration to the statistical statements fixed as exhibits accompanying the within application and is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HERREDY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Facific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to discontinue the maintenance of an agent at its station of Acton in Los Angeles County on its San Josquin Division and to hereafter maintain and operate said station as a non-agency station until the further order of this Commission.
