ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance of its agency station at Bradley in Monterey County on its Coast Division.

Applicant alleges that the business now transacted at Bradley is unremunerative and does not justify the expense of maintaining an agent; that the maintenance of the station as a non-agency will furnish adequate service until sufficient additional business will have been developed to justify the restoration of an agent.

The Commission has given full consideration to the statistical statements of receipts and expenditures filed herein as exhibits and has made its own investigation into the merits of the application. We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the

application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and it hereby is authorized to discontinue the maintenance of an agent at the station of Bradley in Monterey County on its Coast Division and to hereafter maintain and operate such station as a non-agency station until the further order of this Commission.
