ORDER

Joint application was filed with this Commission on August 14, 1924 by Southern Pacific Company and Western Pacific Railroad Company for authority on behalf of Southern Pacific Company to sell, and on behalf of The Western Pacific Railroad Company to purchase an undivided one-half interest in a certain spur track, as shown in red on map (Coast Division Drawing 13968) attached to the application, located at West San Jose, County of Santa Clara. The terms and conditions of sale, joint ownership, operation and maintenance of said spur track are set forth in the agreement made between the parties under date of May 29, 1924, certified copy of which is attached to the application.

It appears to the Commission that the present proceeding is not one in which a public hearing is necessary; that public convenience and necessity will be best served by the granting of the application and the application should be granted.

THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and it is hereby granted in accordance with the agreement heretofore mentioned and attached to the application, provided that within ninety (90) days after the date hereof, Southern Pacific Company shall file with this Commission a verified copy of the instrument of conveyance.

This order shall become effective three (3) days after the making thereof.
