ORDER

ORIGINAL

This proceeding is an application by Earl L. White to transfer to W. MacEwan an operating right for an automobile passenger service between Burbank and Lankershim. The operating right was granted to White, following a public hearing, by the Commission's order in Decision No. 13570 on Application No. 9251. MacEwan joins with White in the application.

No equipment is involved in the proceeding and the consideration named is the nominal sum of \$1.00.

We believe that this application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary on this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1.

1. Applicant Carl L. White shall immediately cancel tariff of rates and time schedules on file covering service, certificate for which is authorized transferred. Such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.

2. Applicant W. MacEwan shall immediately file, in duplicate, or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules as heretofore filed by applicant White covering said service. All rates and time schedules to be identical with those as filed by applicant White.

3. The rights and privileges herein authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission has first been secured.

4. No vehicle may be operated by applicant MacEwan unless such vehicle is owned or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
