ORDER

Paul Bornard, who has been operating an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and express botween Willows and Butte City, serving Clenn as an intermediate point, has asked the Commission for authority to discontinue his operation, setting up the plea that his operation has resulted in monetary loss. Accompanying his request for authority to discontinue was a statement signed by eighteen business men of Butte City, Willows and Glenn, which statement is to the effect that they will not be seriously inconvenienced by the discontinuance of the service.

THURREPORE, good cause appearing,

IT IS HERMEY ORDERED that the certificate of convenience and necessity heretofore granted to O. H. Harper, in Decision No. 10276 on Application No. 7400, and by him transferred, with the approval of the Commission, in its Decision No. 12143, to Paul Bernard, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled, and

IT IS MERESY FURTHER ORDERED that Paul Bernard shall immediately cancel tariff of rates and time schedules filed by him, said cancellation to be in accordance with General Order No. 51 of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
