The County of Los Angeles and Los Angeles County Grade Crossing Committee filed the above entitled application with this Commission, requesting authority to construct overhead crossing of Bridge Street, a county road, over the tracks of the Pacific Electric Railway, near its City Terrace Station on its Covina Line, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

It appears to this Commission that in this proceeding a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to County of Los Angeles and Los Angeles County Grade Crossing Committee to construct overhead crossing to carry Bridge Street over and across the tracks of the Pacific Electric Railway, near its City Terrace Station, on its Covina Line, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown by the maps, Exhibits B and C attached to the application, subject to the condition that said overhead crossing shall be constructed with clearances conforming to provisions of the Commission's

General Orders Nos. 26 and 64.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, public convenience and necessity demand such action.

This order shall become effective three days after the making thereof.
