SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under date of September 8, 1924, the Commission issued its Decision No. 14020 in the above entitled application under which decision the Southern Pacific Company was granted a certificate authorizing operation of a ferry boat service between Richmond and San Francisco. Said order provided in part:

Applicant shall file within a period of not to exceed sixty (60) days tariff of rates identical with the tariff of rates as set forth by the Richmond-San Francisco Transportation Company as amended.

And, good cause appearing, said order is now provided to read:

That the Southern Pacific Company shall file within a period of not to exceed sixty (60) days from date hereof in its own name, tariff of rates identical with the tariff of rates as set forth in Ordinance No. 5990 N.S. of

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Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
of San Francisco, omitting items therein con-  
tained providing rates for the transportation  
of freight other than freight moving upon  
vehicles.
