In the Matter of the application of DAN WISE for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate application No.10,502 passenger (School children) service between Noveto and San Rafeel.

BY WEE COMMISSION:

ORDER

In this proceeding Dan Wise, is asking for authority to operate an automotive service for the transportation of school children only between Newate and San Rafael. Both points are in Marin County.

Wise proposes to transport the children on school days only at a cost of Go.00 per month per child, and to so adjust his time schedule as to depart from and arrive at the school and Novato terminal at hours more convenient for the children than the schedule maintained by the Northwestern Pacific Railroad, and the Santa Rosa, Petaluma and Sausalito Stage Company, common carriers now operating between Movato and San Rafael.

We believe that this application should be granted and that it is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

The Reilroad Commission of the State of California heroby declares that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Dan Wise of an automotive service for the transportation of school children only between Novato and San Rufuel, said operation to be conducted only on the days school is in session at San Rafael.

IT IS HERREY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

- l. Applicant herein shall file within a period of not to exceed ten (10) days from date hereof his written acceptance of the certificate herein granted; shall file within a period of not to exceed twenty (20) days from date hereof tariff of rates and time schedules, in duplicate, in accordance with those submitted with the application herein; and shall commence operation of the service herein authorized within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date hereof.
- 2. The rights and privileges herein authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission has first been secured.
- 3. No vehicle may be operated by applicant unless such vehicle is owned by him or is lessed under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Radlroad Commission.
