SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Among the conditions imposed by the Commission in its order granting an operating right to B. N. Tucker is a requirement that he accept said operating right as an extension of his "present right and not as a new or separate operating right." Tucker has not, heretofore, been granted an operating right, and therefore, the acceptance requirement as described above is in error, and should be eliminated. The following paragraph should be substituted:

Applicant shell file his written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed fifteen (15) days from date hereof; shall file, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules covering service herein authorized within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date hereof; and shall commence operation of said service within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date hereof.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paragraph No. 1, among

the conditions named in the Commission's order in Decision No. 14,112, be eliminated therefrom and that the above be substituted therefor, the order in all other respects to remain as originally issued.
