O R D E R

This proceeding is a joint application by
Oliver A. Cooper and Joshua A. Madden, the former asking for
authority to transfer and the latter permission to acquire a
certificate of convenience and necessity for an automotive
service for the transportation of passengers and freight bet-
ween Fort Seward and Blocksburg, both points being located
in Humboldt County. The certificate in question was granted
to Cooper by the Railroad Commission in Decision No. 11073,
on Application No. 8151.

The consideration to be paid for the property
it is proposed to transfer is given as \$1,000, this sum being
named as the value of the operating right and the equipment
used by Cooper in maintaining service.

We believe that this application should be granted,
and that it is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized transferred may not be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. Applicant Cooper shall immediately cancel tariff of rates and time schedules on file with the Commission covering service, certificate for which is herein authorized transferred. Such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.

3. Applicant Madden shall immediately file in duplicate, in his own name, or adopt as his own tariff of rates and time schedules as heretofore filed by applicant Cooper for said service. All tariff filings by applicant Madden to be identical with those as at present on file by applicant Cooper.

4. The rights and privileges herein authorized transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission thereto has first been obtained.

5. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Madden unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
