FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Reilroad Commission by Decision Number 14175 dated October 16, 1924, authorized San Gorgonic Power Company to issue and sell on or before Decomber 31, 1924, \$5,000.00 of bonds and use the proceeds to pay in part the following expenses:-

To pay amounts representing materials purchased To cover lower canal To construct steel by-pass from tank No. 2 To complete storm control dams To construct fire breaks and trails To pay interest Miscellaneous

To pay excess cost of plants constructed Total	39,027,90 \$85,708,46

The company now has advised the Commission that it will not use any of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the bonds to refund interest payments. It therefore asks the Commission to modify its order and make a finding that the company may use the proceeds obtained from the sale of the bonds for the purposes specified in the Commission's order and that such purposes are not in whole or in part reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income.

The Commission has considered applicant's request and believes that the order in Decision Number 14175 dated October 16, 1924, should be modified, as herein provided;

The San Gorgonio Power Company having applied to the Reilroad Commission for permission to use \$5,000.00 of bonds, a public hearing having been held before Examiner Fankhauser and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for through the issue of bonds is reasonably required by applicant for the purpose or purposes specified in this order, and that such purpose or purposes are not in whole or in part reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the San Gorgonio Power Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to issue and sell on or before December 31, 1924, \$5,000.00 of its seven percent. bonds and use the proceeds to pay in part the cost of the following improvements:-

To pay amounts representing materials purchased\$3,000.00To cover lower canal5,000.00To construct steel by-pass from Tank No. 23,000.00To complete storm control dams12,000.00To construct fire breaks and trails6,000.00To finance excess cost of plants39,027,90Miscellaneous3,680.56

TOTAL..... <u>\$71,708.46</u>

PROVIDED, that only such costs as are properly chargeable to fixed capital accounts under the Uniform System of Accounts prescribed by the Railroad Commission may be paid through the use of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the \$5,000.00 of bonds.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 14175 dated October 16, 1924, shall remain in full force and
