SAN FRANCISCO-SACRAMENTO RAILROAD COMPANY

This Commission, on March 4th, 1924, having ordered (Decision 13244) the San Francisco-Sacramento Railroad Company to reconstruct its overhead facilities to conform with the provisions of Chapter 499, Statutes of 1911 as amended by Chapter 600, Statutes of 1915, before January 1st, 1925, and San Francisco-Sacramento Railroad Company having requested a further extension of time to reconstruct the facilities mentioned in California Railroad Commission's Report of Infractions of Chapter 499-600 on the San Francisco-Sacramento Railroad Company's system, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time during which the San Francisco-Sacramento Railroad Company may eliminate infractions of Chapter 499, Statutes of 1911 as amended by Chapter 600, Statutes of 1915, as designated by the report and item numbers hereinafter specified be, and the same is hereby, extended as follows:

Item 13 on Page 1 to Item 1 of Page 7, inclusive,
extended to January 1st, 1925.
