## <u>ÓPINION</u>

The complaint in this proceeding alleges that the defendants are operating a water system in a "mysterious manner" so as to infringe upon the rights of the complainant, and prays for an order of this Commission restraining such infringement.

Public hearings were held upon the matter in Los Angeles on January 11, and February 7, 1924, at which time oral and documentary evidence was offered by both complainant and defendants. After a careful examination of the record the Commission is unable to find any evidence in support of the complainant's allegation that its rights are being infringed. The proceeding, therefore, should be dismissed.

## ORDER

Complaint having been made as above entitled, public hearings having been held thereon, the matter having been submitted and the Commission being now fully informed in the premises.--

IT IS HEPEBY ORDERED that the above-entitled proceeding be, and the same is hereby dismissed.
