BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern California Edison Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to sell to the City of Glendale certain electrical facilities owned by Southern California Edison Company and located principally within territory recently annexed to the City of Glendale, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that such authority should be given,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

(1) Southern California Edison Company be and it is authorized to sell to the City of Glendale the electric distribution lines specifically described in the form of indenture attached to the application in this matter and marked Exhibit "A" thereof on the terms and under the conditions set forth therein;

(2) The price at which such electric distribution lines are herein authorized to be transferred is approved for the purposes of this proceeding only;

(3) The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall be made on or before January 31, 1925;

(4) On or before January 31, 1925, Southern California Edison Company shall file with this Commission a statement showing the

date upon which the transfer was made.
