

BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Dan Wise, to whom, in Decision No. 14173 on
Application No. 10502, the Commission granted a certificate of
convenience and necessity authorizing operation of an automotive
service for the transportation of school children only between
Novato and the High School at San Rafael, has not complied with
the Commission's order that he observe Rule 8 of the Railroad
Commission's Automobile Stage and Truck Safety Rules and Operating
Regulations as contained in Decision No. 4814 on Case No. 1110,
which reads as follows:

"Age and Competency of Drivers of Motors.

8. Drivers of vehicles shall be at least twenty-one (21) years of age, of good moral character, shall be fully competent to operate the vehicles under their charge and shall hold license from the State Motor Vehicle Department as required by Section 24, paragraph (a) of the Motor Vehicle Act."

THEREFORE, good cause appearing,

IT IS HERRBY ORDERED that the certificate heretofore

granted Dam Wise in Decision No. 14173, on Application No. 10502 be and the same is hereby suspended pending further action by the Commission.
