O P I N I O N

This is an application of Lewis A. Monroe, as Agent for V.L and F.L. Haynes, owners of an auto truck line operating under the fictitious name of Western Truck Line between Fresno and Hanford, and Fresno and Lemoore and intermediate points, for permission to publish and file on full statutory notice a line of class rates and Monroe's "Ship by Truck" Freight Classification to be used as basis for the assessment of freight charges, as shown in Exhibit A attached to and made a part of the application. The present tariff, effective June 19, 1920, is inadequate to meet the carrier's requirements, no consideration having been given to a proper classification of the commodities being handled and it is in a very incomplete form.

Applicant states the readjustment is not sought with a view of securing any increase in revenue, but solely to establish a uniform method of applying charges and will give to shippers a more equitable adjustment of charges.

In view of the circumstances mentioned, the Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.
