ORDER

In this proceeding Mrs. F.C.Williams, owner of certificates of convenience and necessity to operate an auto truck freight line between Bakersfield and Shafter and Wasco, as granted by the Commission in its orders issued on Applications Nos. 7258 and 8024, asks for authority to transfer the certificates, or permits to operate, to J. I. Kimbriel. The latter asks for authority to acquire the certificates and to operate thereunder.

The consideration to be paid for the property proposed to be transferred is given as \$3,000.00. This sum is said to represent the value of the operating rights and the good will of the business established and conducted over a period of years by Mrs. Williams. No equipment is involved in the transfer.

We believe it is not necessary to hold a public hearing on this matter and that the application should be granted subject to the usual provision regarding any claim that may be made in rate or other proceedings before the

Commission based on the values set forth in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized transferred shall not be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. Applicant Mrs. F.C. Williams shall immediately cancel tariff of rates and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission covering service, certificates for which are herein authorized transferred. Such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.

3. Applicant Kimbriel shall immediately file in duplicate, in his own name, or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules heretofore filed by applicant Mrs. Williams covering said service. All rates and time schedules of applicant Kimbriel to be identical with those now on file by applicant Mrs. Williams covering said service.

4. The rights and privileges herein authorized transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission thereto has first been secured.

5. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Kimbriel unless such vehicle is owned or is leased under a contract on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
