ORDER

Application having been filed with the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing John V. Leithold to sell, and Oscar Reinhardt to purchase Knights Landing Telephone Exchange for two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), and it appearing that this transfer will be in the interest of the subscribers of this exchange and of the public, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that John V. Leithold be, and he is hereby authorized to sell and transfer to Oscar Reinhardt the Knights Landing Exchange, and that Oscar Reinhardt be, and he is hereby authorized to purchase the same for two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00); provided, that this transfer shall have been made on or before March 31, 1925, and provided, a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance of said property shall be filed with this Commission within a period of thirty (30) days after the date of its execution.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Oscar Reinhardt shall file with the Railroad Commission within a period of thirty (30) days of the date of the execution of said instrument of conveyance, a schedule of the rates now in effect in Knights Landing Exchange, together with rules and regulations governing telephone service therein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the consideration for the transfer of this telephone property shall not be considered as a measure of value of said property for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
