Southern California Edison Company and City of Anaheim
having applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing
said company to sell to said city for the sum of One thousand
seven hundred twenty-four dollars and four cents (\$1,724.04)
certain poles, wires and appurtenances heretofore used by said
company in the distribution of electricity in territory recently
annexed to the city of Anaheim, and other good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

(1) Southern California Edison Company be, and it is,
authorized to sell to City of Anaheim for the sum of One thousand
seven hundred twenty-four dollars and four cents (\$1,724.04)
certain poles, cross arms, insulators, wires and other appurtenances,
more particularly described in the form of indenture attached to the
application in this matter and marked Exhibit "A" thereon.

(2) The transfer of said property shall be evidenced by
the execution of an indenture substantially in the form set forth
in Exhibit "A" of the application in this matter.

(3) The price at which said property is hereby authorized
to be transferred is approved for the purposes of this transaction

only, and such approval shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of the value of said property.

(4) The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as may be made on or before March 31, 1925.
