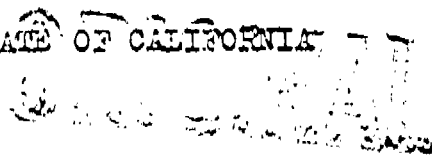

BY THE COMMISSION:

FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

San Fernando Telephone and Telegraph Company by Decision Number 9197 dated June 30, 1921 was authorized to issue and sell \$10,000.00 of its common stock for cash at not less than its par value.

The order of the Commission, as amended from time to time, permits the company to use not exceeding \$9,735.10 of the proceeds from the sale of stock to finance construction expenditures, but provides that the remaining proceeds of \$264.90 be deposited in a special fund and expended only for such purposes as the Commission might authorize in supplemental orders.

The company now reports that during 1924 it incurred expenses for new construction work amounting to \$264.90 as follows:-

July 8, 1924, Basoe and Bernhards, building manholes . . .	\$118.85
July 29, 1924, Western Electric Company, fibre wire . . .	138.04
Dec. 22, 1924, Coker Electric Company, part payment wire and tape	8.01

Total \$264.90

It asks the Commission to make a supplemental order authorizing it to use the proceeds of \$264.90 to finance the cost of these construction expenditures, which it appears have not been paid or provided for through the issue of stock.

The Commission has given consideration to applicant's request and believes it should be granted as herein provided, therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Fernando Telephone and Telegraph Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to use the remaining proceeds of \$264.90 which were received from the sale of the stock authorized by Decision Number 9197 dated June 30, 1921, to finance the cost of additions, betterments and extensions to which reference is made herein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 9197 dated June 30, 1921, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Fourth Supplemental Order.
