ORDER

This proceeding is an application by E.B.Brown for authority to discontinue operation of an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and express between Needles and a point on the California-Nevada State line on the road leading to Searchlight, Nevada. Authority to establish the service was granted Brown by the Railroad Commission in Decision No. 13783 on Application No. 10220 dated July 7, 1924.

The service has been operated without profit ever since its inception, the monetary loss approximating \$100 a month. The territory served is sparsely settled and there does not appear to be any hope for any increase in traffic at least for some time to come.

We believe that this application should be granted and that it is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application
be and the same hereby is granted, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of
public convenience and necessity heretofore granted E.B.Brown
in Decision No. 13783 on Application No. 10220, be and the same
is hereby revoked and annulled.
