BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Ernest T. Minney, who owns and operates a small public utility water system which provides domestic service for some 60 consumers in the realty subdivision known as the Moss Estate Tract located in the City of Oakland, California, having made application for authority to transfer all of said water system, more particularly described in the application, to the East Bay Water Company, a corporation, and the East Bay Water Company having joined in the application; and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ernest T. Minney be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to East Bay Water Company, a corporation, that certain public utility water distribution system more particularly described in the application herein, upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted to transfer said water system shall apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before June 30, 1925, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance specifically describing and setting forth the items of property thereby transferred shall be filed with this Commission by East Bay Water Company within twenty (20) days from the date on which it is executed.

2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Ernest T. Minney relinquishes control and possession of the public utility property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date on which such control and possession was actually relinquished.
3. The consideration given for the transfer of this property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of the property for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

The authority granted in the order herein shall become effective on the date hereof.
