ORDER DENYING REHEARING

The Railroad Commission, by its Decision No. 14422, rendered December 31, 1924, in above entitled proceedings, authorized Sutter Butte Canal Company to put into effect a new schedule of rates for irrigation service, and on January 19, 1925, a petition for rehearing herein was filed by the Protective Water Users' Association of Butte and Sutter Counties by and through Mrs. Artie Nugent.

After a careful study and consideration of this petition it appears that the matters involved in all the points raised therein have been fully considered heretofore by the Commission in preparation of and in arriving at its decision which was rendered in above entitled proceedings, and therefore we find no justification for granting a rehearing as requested.

Petition for rehearing having been filed in above entitled matters, as hereinbefore mentioned, and the Railroad

Commission being of the opinion that no good cause therefor has been advanced, and that no good purpose can be served at the present time by re-opening the matter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said petition for rehearing be, and the same is, hereby denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
