ORDER

This proceeding is an application by Coast Truck Line, a corporation, for a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate an auto service for the transportation of freight between Los Angeles and San Diego, via Escondido.

The applicant already operates a daily auto freight service between Los Angeles and San Diego, via what is known commonly as the Coast route. Applicant also operates an auto freight service between Los Angeles and Escondido, via Oceanside, the Escondido-Los Angeles schedule of service calling for three round trips per week. Both of these operations have been authorized by the Commission. The instant application, if granted, will permit the establishment of daily service between Los Angeles and Escondido, it being the intention of Coast Truck Line to route some of its Los Angeles-San Diego trucks via Escondido, these trucks to haul trailers carrying the freight destined to Escondido. Furthermore, it is proposed to utilize the Escondido-San Diego highway for the transportation of large shipments of freight between Los Angeles and

San Diego, to avoid what is known as the Torrey Pines Grade on the Coast highway, the Escondido highway permitting the use of trucks and trailers. It is not proposed to serve any new points but simply to use a new road and expedite and facilitate a service to terminal points already being given.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter requiring a public hearing and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Coast Truck Line, a corporation, of an auto service for the transportation of freight between Los Angeles and San Diego, via Oceanside and Escondido, the operation to be conducted in connection with and as a part of the service now being given by Coast Truck Line between Los Angeles and San Diego and Los Angeles and Escondido.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

Applicant shall file his written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed ten (10) days, which acceptance shall contain a declaration that the applicant understands that said certificate in no way enlarges the operating rights of applicant except in that it permits use of the highway between Escondido and San Diego for the transportation of freight between San Diego and Los Angeles.
