O R D E R

This is an application for an order by the Commission approving the transfer of a certificate of convenience and necessity covering an auto service for the transportation of passengers and freight between Big Pine and Deep Springs.

The applicants are Abe Ransom, as Administrator of the Estate of James H. Ransome, to whom the certificate was originally granted by the Commission in Decision No.11390 on Application No.8371, and Abe Ransom as purchaser of the stage line. The nominal sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) named as the consideration for the transfer.

The certificate granted to Jas. H. Ransome authorized operation of a stage line for the transportation of passengers and baggage between Big Pine and Deep Springs and any intermediate points easterly from Zurich. No freight service was authorized between Big Pine and Deep Springs and tariffs filed by Ransome to meet the requirements of the Commission's order show only passenger fares and an excess baggage rate of one cent (1¢) a pound, with a weight limitation of 250 pounds on the baggage.

We believe that this application should be granted and that it is not a matter requiring a public hearing. It must be understood, however, that the operative right transferred herein conveys no authority to transport freight.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
2. Applicant Abe Ransom, as Administrator of the Estate of James H. Ransome, shall immediately cancel tariff of rates and time schedules on file with the Commission covering service, certificate for which is herein authorized to be transferred. Such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.
3. Applicant Abe Ransom shall immediately file, in duplicate, tariffs of rates and time schedules or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules for said service as heretofore filed by applicant Jas. H. Ransome. All tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those as filed by applicant Jas. H. Ransome.
4. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred shall not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.
5. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Abe Ransom unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
