FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first sentence of Condition 1 of Decision No. 14515, dated January 30th, 1925, in the above entitled application, reading:

"(1) The entire expense of constructing the pedestrian crossing up to and including the sum of One Hundred and Five Dollars (\$105.00) shall be borne by applicant."

be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) The entire expense of constructing the pedestrian crossing up to and including the sum of One Hundred and Five Dollars (\$105.00) shall be borne by the City of Seal Beach, County of Orange, State of California.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 14515 of this Commission, dated January 30th, 1925, be and it is hereby amended and corrected to the extent of substituting the words "County of Orange" for the words "County of Los Angeles" in all places in said Decision No. 14515 where said words "County of Los Angeles" appear.

In all other respects the Order of this Commission
