FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

This Commission, on September 27, 1924, Decision No. 14108, having ordered Napa Valley Electric Company to complete the reconstruction of its overhead electric lines in order to comply with the provisions of Chapter 499, Statutes of 1911 as amended by Chapter 600, Statutes of 1915, before January 1, 1925, and Napa Valley Electric Company having requested a further extension of time to bring it's electric facilities into compliance with the provisions of the above mentioned statutes, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time during which Napa Valley Electric Company may bring it's facilities into compliance with the provisions of Chapter 499, Statutes of 1911 as amended by Chapter 600, Statutes of 1915, be and the same is hereby extended to July 1, 1925.
