ORDER

In the public utility business of supplying water for domestic and other purposes in and in the vicinity of the unincorporated town of Gardena, Los Angeles County, having applied to this Commission for authority to transfer certain real property in exchange for certain other real property adjoining the land upon which the company's pumping plant is located; and it appearing that the property to be transferred is neither necessary nor useful in the performance of the duties of said company as a water utility, and that the acquisition of the property to be acquired will facilitate the future development and operation of said company, and that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Los Angeles County Water Works, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to sell that certain real property more particularly described in the application herein, and according to the terms thereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED:

- 1. That the authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1925.
- 2. That a certified copy of the instrument of conveyence shell be filed with this Commission by said Los Angeles County Water Works within thirty (30) days from the date upon which it is executed.

The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
