ORDER

ORIGINAL

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight shed heretofore maintained at the station of Lugo on the Santa Ana Line of its Southern Division.

Applicant alleges that the freight shed was originally located at its non-agency station of Lugo for the handling of less than carload shipments and principally for the loading of milk shipments; that the milk shipments have ceased and that there has been no freight handled at this station for a period of over a year; that there is no necessity for the continued maintenance of the freight shed, the locality in its vicinity having been developed as a residential district from which it is desirable that the freight shed be removed.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is

authorized to abandon and remove its freight shed as heretofore maintained at its station of Lugo on the Santa Ana Line of its Southern Division.
