FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In a letter received by the Railroad Commission on April 8, 1925, Mrs. A. S. Stafford advised the Commission that because of illness, A. S. Stafford, her husband, had been compelled to discontinue, in October, 1924, operation of the auto stage line he had been operating under authority of the Commission between San Rafael and Lagunitas and intermediate points. The certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing this service was granted to Stafford by the Commission in Decision No. 13580, dated May 21, 1924, on Application No. 8986. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of convenience and necessity heretofore granted to A. S. Stafford in Decision No. 13580, on Application No. 8986, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
