SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record in the above entitled proceeding and of petition filed by complainants, East-West Refining Company, a corporation, and J.W. Jameson Corporation, a corporation, for a modification of the opinion and order (Decision No. 14629, March 5, 1925) so as to eliminate entirely these two petitioners as parties complainant in this proceeding, upon the grounds that they were also parties complainant in Case No. 2023 (Decision No. 14533, February 5, 1925) and that the proceedings being parallel, the issues, insofar as these two petitioners are concerned, were satisfied and concluded by Case No. 2023, and that petitioners

should not have been parties to the second proceeding insofar as it involved crude and fuel oils.

IT IS ORDERED that the findings in Case No. 2038, Decision No. 14629, March 5, 1925, be and they are hereby amended so as to strike out and eliminate all reference to East-West Refining Company and J.W. Jameson Corporation as parties complainant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, except as herein provided, the opinion and order in Case No. 2038 remain in full force and effect.
