O R D E R

L. W. Gregg and Minnie Gregg, his wife, having made application to this Commission as entitled above, for permission to sell the water system owned and operated by them in Lankershim Annexation District, Los Angeles County, to the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation, which joins in the application; and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that L. W. Gregg and Minnie Gregg, his wife, be and they are hereby authorized to transfer to the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation, for the sum of \$49,980, the water distributing system located in Municipal Improvement District No. 27

and known as Lankershim Annexation District, County of Los Angeles, said property being more particularly described in the application herein, upon the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before July 31, 1925, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by L. W. Gregg and Minnie Gregg within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which L. W. Gregg and Minnie Gregg actually relinquish control and possession of the property herein authorized to be sold, they shall file with the Commission a certified statement indicating the date on which such control and possession was relinquished.
3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
