BY THE COMMISSION -

O R D E R

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a shelter station heretofore maintained at its station of Cudahy in Los Angeles County.

Applicant alleges that the public convenience and necessity does not require the further maintenance of the shelter station; that during the months of February and March, 1925, but eight passengers were handled to or from Cudahy station; that but approximately a total of four passengers per month have been handled to or from said station for the yearly period ending with the month of March, 1925; and that such limited patronage has been accorded for a number of years last past.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon and remove its passenger shelter station located at Cudahy in Los Angeles County; provided, however, that the authority hereby conveyed does not authorize any change in the train schedules serving such station, all trains now serving the station,

either by regular or flag stops, to continue stopping for the convenience of passengers boarding or leaving such trains.
