ORDER

Central Warehouse & Storage Company, a corporation engaged in the general warehousing business at No. 447 Commercial Street, Los Angeles, having applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing it to issue and sell, at par, for cash, \$700.00 of its common capital stock for the purpose of paying for furniture, floor trucks, office fixtures, equipment and supplies incidental to its warehousing business, a public hearing having been held before Examiner Williams, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by such issue and sale of stock is reasonably required by applicant for the purposes specified herein, and that the expenditures for such purposes are not in whole or in part reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Central Warehouse & Storage Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to issue and sell, at par, for cash, on or before September 1, 1925, \$700.00 of its common capital stock for the purposes indicated herein, such authority to become effective

upon the date hereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant keep such record of the issue, sale and delivery of the stock herein authorized and of the disposition of the proceeds as will enable it to file on or before the 25th day of each month a verified report, as required by the Railroad Commission's General Order No. 24, which order in so far as applicable, is made a part of this order.
