FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, C. R. Carpenter, operator of a stage line between Salinas and Monterey has, under date of May 14, 1925, made a written request to the Railroad Commission for authority to abandon service between the points above named, and for an order of the Commission revoking and annulling the certificate of convenience and necessity under which said operation has been conducted, said certificate having been acquired by Carpenter from Merle Kramer, as shown by the Commission's Decision No. 6920, dated December 9, 1919, on Application No. 5091, and

WHEREAS, abandonment of the service as proposed herein will not work any hardship on or inconvenience the traveling public by reason of the fact that Carpenter and one E. E. Littlefield, as a co-partnership, is operating between Monterey and Salinas under authority of a certificate granted by the Commission in Decision No. 13185, dated February 20, 1924, on Application No. 9745, and therefore,

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity as heretofore transferred to C.R. Carpenter, an individual, by Merle Kramer, under authority of the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 6920, dated December 9, 1919, on

application No. 5091 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that G. R. Carpenter shall immediately cancel all rates and time schedules now filed with the Railroad Commission by Merle Bremer, which rates and time schedules were adopted by G. R. Carpenter in accordance with the Commission's order in Decision No. 6920.
