IT IS MEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that C. R. Carpenter shall immediately cancel all rates and time schedules now filed with the Railroad Commission by Merle Kramer, which rates and time schedules were adopted by G. R. Carpenter in accordance with the Commission's order in Decision No.6920.
