FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Renfro has requested, in writing, under date of June 3, 1925, that the certificate of public convenience and necessity permitting him to operate an auto stage for the transportation of school children only between Folsom, Orangevale and the San Juan High School, as heretofore granted by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 11,375, dated December 22, 1922, on Application No. 8373, be revoked and annulled, and

WHEREAS, said request is based on the termination, on June 6, 1925, of Renfro's contract with the school board, therefore,
Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to D.W. Renfro in Decision No. 11,375 on Application No. 8373 be, and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
