FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision
No. 14644 dated March 10, 1925, in the above entitled matter,
authorized Laguna Beach Telephone Co., a corporation, among
other things, to issue and sell \$8,000.00 of notes, payable on
or before three years after date with interest at not exceeding
seven percent per annum, for the purpose of financing the cost
of certain extensions, additions and betterments specifically
set forth in said decision; and

WHEREAS, applicant has now requested the Commission for permission to use approximately \$5,500.00 of the proceeds to be received through the issue of its notes for purposes

different from those heretofore specified in the Commission's orders; and

WHEREAS, applicant reports that the expenditures it now proposes to make consist of the purchase of a lot in Laguna Beach and the erection of a one story stucco building 20 x 30 feet in dimension at an estimated cost of \$5,500.00; and

WHEREAS the Commission has given consideration to applicant's request and believes it should be granted as herein provided,

IT IS EMPERY ORDERED that the order in Decision
No. 14644 dated Merch 10, 1925 be, and it is hereby, modified
so as to permit Laguna Beach Telephone Co. to use approximately
\$5,500.00 of the proceeds received or to be received through
the issue of the notes authorized by said decision for the
purpose of financing the cost of acquiring the lot and erecting
the one-story stucco building to which reference is made herein.

IT IS HERREY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 14644 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
