O P I N I O N

In this application the Railroad Commission is asked to make an order authorizing A. B. Perkins to sell to Joseph D. O'Brien and Agnes K. O'Brien an undivided one half interest in the public utility water system supplying the Town of Newhall, Los Angeles County, and known as Newhall Water System.

By Decision No. 12117 dated May 19, 1923 in Application No. 8826 the Commission adjusted applicant's rates. The opinion in that decision recites that Mr. F. E. Van Hoosen, one of the Commission's hydraulic engineers, submitted a report covering the results of an investigation of the system and estimated the original cost as of May 1, 1923 as \$34,636.00. In making the present application A. B. Perkins estimates the value of the water properties, based on the Commission's engineer's appraisal with additions and betterments made subsequent thereto, as approximately \$35,000.00. He reports that there is outstanding a five year

1. The price at which A. B. Perkins is herein authorized to transfer an undivided one half interest shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
2. A. B. Perkins shall advise the Commission of the actual date of transfer of the undivided one half interest in his properties and shall file with

the Commission within thirty days after execution,
a certified copy of the grant deed by which con-
veyance is made.

3. The authority herein granted shall become effective upon
the date hereof.
