FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 11070, dated October 7, 1922, on Application No. 8088, granted to W. R. De Wolf, applicant herein, a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an auto stage service between Placerville and El Dorado and the intermediate point of Diamond Springs, and

WHEREAS, said W. R. De Wolf, after filing an application for a rehearing in the matter, said application being dated October 21, 1922, moved from the Diamond Springs territory, and

WHEREAS, a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing auto service between the points proposed to be served by De Wolf, has been granted to Pierce Arrow Stage, L. L. Richardson, Owner, following a public hearing at which De Wolf did not appear to oppose said application, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application for a rehearing heretofore filed by W. R. De Wolf in the above entitled proceeding be and the same hereby is dismissed, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to W. R. DeWolf

in Decision No.11070, dated October 7, 1922, on Application No.8088, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
