FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Al Askin Stage Company, a co-partnership consist-  
ing of E. L. Askin, W. G. Ogilvie and Fred N. Ogilvie, having  
advised the Railroad Commission that their auto stage line oper-  
ations between Visalia and Lemon Cove has been conducted at a  
heavy monetary loss, and that such deficit will be further in-  
creased by the operation of a school bus service by the school  
district, thereby further curtailing available patronage, and

WHEREAS, the co-partnership herein above named has requested  
authority to discontinue auto stage service between Visalia and  
Lemon Cove, now therefore

Good Cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Al Askin Stage Company be  
authorized to discontinue auto stage service between Visalia and  
Lemon Cove and to immediately file cancellation of tariffs and  
time schedules covering such service as now on file with the  
Railroad Commission, and

convenience and necessity authorizing such service heretofore
