SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record and the order entered in the above entitled proceeding on July 31, 1925, and Good Cause Appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that said order of July 31, 1925 be, and the same is hereby, amended so as to provide that the defendant, Southern Pacific Company, be and it is hereby authorized and directed to refund to complainant, Anaheim Sugar Company, all charges it may have collected, on the shipments involved in this proceeding, in excess of 3 cents

per 100 pounds, minimum carload weight 60000 pounds, moved during the period August 2, 1920 to August 25, 1920, inclusive, and 4 cents per 100 pounds; minimum carload weight 60000 pounds, moved during the period August 26, 1920 to August 30, 1920, inclusive.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said opinion and order of July 31, 1925 shall continue in full force and effect.
