ORDER

D. G. Johns and G. R. Goold each owned a one half interest in and were the operators of The Sunnyside Water Works System, a small public utility serving water for domestic purposes in the Sunnyside Addition to the City of Stockton. In this application D. G. Johns asks authority from the Commission to purchase the half interest in the above system owned by said G. R. Goold, who joins in the application. It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that G. R. Goold be and he is hereby authorized to sell all interests and rights owned by him in The Sunnyside Water Works System in the City of Stockton to D. G. Johns, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The consideration for the transfer herein suthorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
- 2. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before October 31, 1925, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by D. G. Johns within

thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

3. On or before the thirty-first day of October, 1925, D. G. Johns shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which he assumed complete control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred.

The suthority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
