ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This application filed by Oakland Terminal and Elevator Corporation was set down for hearing on July 29th. The company asks permission to organize a new corporation to be known as Oakland Terminal and Elevator Company, which company is to be permitted to issue stock. At that hearing representatives of applicant were advised that the application did not comply with the Rules of Procedure of the Commission, and that the Oakland Terminal and Elevator Company, which the Commission was asked to authorize the issue of stock, was not a party to Application No. 11461, nor had such company filed an application with the Commission for permission to issue stock. To give the parties in interest an opportunity to amend the application or file a new application on behalf of the Oakland Terminal and Elevator Company, the hearing was continued to August 17th. Further continuations were granted from time to time to August 31st and September 17th. At the hearing on September 17th no one representing either the Oakland Terminal and Elevator Corporation or the Oakland Terminal and Elevator Company, appeared.

Inasmuch as the above numbered application does not comply with the Rules of Procedure of the Commission, and further, for the reason that no one representing the company, referred to in said application, appeared at the hearing on September 17th, the Commission has concluded to dismiss Application No. 11461 without prejudice.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above numbered application be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.
