In the Matter of the application of M. C. Merrell for authority to sell an electric distribution system to James Fisher and the Yosemite Lodge Number 97 I.O.O.F., Trustees - Charles P. Hall, Budd C. Eaton and John R. Goldsworthy.

O R D E R

M. C. Merrell having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to sell to James Fisher and Yosemite Lodge No. 97, I. O. O. F. a small electric distribution system serving approximately twenty (20) consumers in the unincorporated town of Big Oak Flat, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that such sale should be authorized, and that a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That M. C. Merrell be and he is hereby authorized to sell to James Fisher and Yosemite Lodge No. 97 I. O. O. F. that certain electric distribution system located in the unincorporated town of Big Oak Flat and more particularly described in the form of Bill of Sale attached to the application in this matter and made a part thereof;

(2) That the price at which this transfer is made shall never be urged before this Commission or any court or public body as establishing the value of the property herein authorized to be transferred;

(3) That James Fisher and Yosemite Lodge No. 97 I. O. O. F. before October 15, 1925, file with this Commission a copy of the rules

and regulations to be used in the conduct of the utility business thus to be acquired and of the rates to be charged for energy hereafter to be supplied, said rates to be not in excess of those previously charged by M. C. Merrell;

(4) That the authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as may be made on or before December 1, 1925.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
