BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

WHEREAS, Sierra Madre Telephone & Telegraph Co. having filed an application with this Commission, requesting authority to establish throughout the territory served by it public telephone stations as may be necessary, and to establish a charge of five (5) cents for each local call made from each such public telephone station, and

WHEREAS, the rendering of public pay station service will be in the interest of the subscribers of the Sierra Madre Telephone & Telegraph Co. and to the public, and it appearing that applicant's request is reasonable and that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Sierra Madre Telephone & Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to establish throughout the territory served by it public telephone stations as may be necessary to render adequate service to the public and to charge the sum of five (5) cents for each local call made from each such public telephone station, on and after November 1st, 1925,

Providing that said rate be filed with this
Commission on or before October 31, 1925.
